



## DESCRIPTION OF COURSES TAUGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FACULTATIVE HUMANITARIAN REQUIREMENTS

| <p>Islamic Culture manifests three major related dimensions: First, the pillars of the Islamic community, the rights and the responsibilities in the Islamic regime, and the basics upon which Muslims rely to deal with other non-Muslim individuals. The second field of the course covers the approximate concepts whereas the last part of this course sheds the light on the interactive relationships between Islamic and non-Islamic cultures by focusing on the various sources of Islamic culture.</p>  |                            |                |

| <p>It is a prerequisite for all students with 3 credit hours. The course flourishes the concept of national security in reference to the Jordanian social traditional aspect. It also aims to instill the spirit of patriotism and belongingness for the people, the constitution, the military as well as the security defenses of our home country in younger generations which, in turn, qualifies the youth for their future roles and enhances their confidence in the security and military establishments. This evolves in not only creating room for positive developments but also supporting our country's stability and enriching the students' background of the foundation, the emergence of military systems, and the prosperity of our Kingdome.</p> |                            |                |

| <p>This course trains students to analyze a number of Arabic texts of different subjects extracted from the Arabic tradition and different sequential literary eras in terms of linguistic, syntactic, and lexical aspects. In this course, students are also provided with a variety of essential writing skills. This will eventually develop the capabilities of students to understand, write, and speak the native Arabic</p>   |                            |                |



language in a proper way. The method of studying is based on indulging the students in many exercises to explore different cultural and literary linguistic techniques in addition to different writing styles which Arabic language scholars employed during previous eras. Students, in this course, are also guided to write different forms of technical writing, such as: formal letters, reports, articles, and applications memo.

This course aims at deeply rooting loyalty of Arabic and Islamic Jerusalem in the concept of student - since Jerusalem is considered Moslems' First Qiblah- by supplying him/her with precise historical and scientific knowledge that meet attempts of doubts, defamations, and Judaization being made by Zionist entity, through studying the history of political and civilized Jerusalem since the dawn of time and historic milestones; Islamic history, attempts and projects of Judaization, and Hashemite role in preserving Jerusalem's Arabism and reconstruction of Islamic and Christian sacred and holy places.

| <b>5001180</b>          | <b>Introduction to Education</b>              | This course deals with the definition of education, educational concepts and trends, applications of education, areas of education, means of education, the historical, philosophical, psychological, and economic foundations of education in Jordan.  |                            |

| <b>5001181</b>          | <b>Introduction to Educational Psychology</b> | Introducing the nature of psychology as an independent science, its origins and development, its fields and branches, its schools, and its characteristics. The course also deals with research methods in psychological sciences, components of human behavior and its determinants. The course also discusses the psychological development of the child and its relationship to socialization, motives, attitudes, values and emotions, mental abilities, and mental processes such as attention, awareness, remembering and forgetting. The course also discusses the psychology of learning and its theories, an introduction to psychometrics, the concept of personality and its theories, mental health and aspects of normal and abnormal behavior.  |                            |

| <b>5001182</b>          | <b>Family Organization and Society</b>        | Basic concepts in household planning: the concept and importance of family, its role and status in society, and the attention Islam paid to it prior to its establishment (prenuptial agreement prior to marriage contract: spouse specifications, the engagement; its legitimacy, advantages and the rules of the relationship between the engaged couple), during its establishment (the consequences of marriage contract: material and moral rights of each spouse over the other, emotional relationships in Islam, ethics of family dealings, rights of children and relatives imposed by the outcomes of marriage contract), and in cases of family breakdown (the risks it is exposed to, the legitimate measures that prevent conflict and family disintegration and the avoidance of marriage contract). The impact of media content and social media on households, spinsterhood, the concept of gender, international laws and covenants related to the family in Islam, reproductive health and birth control, disciplines and foundations of relationships, social relations in Islamic society in light of contemporary transformations and updates. |                            |

| <b>5001126</b>          | <b>History of Islamic Civilization</b>        | This course aims to form a knowledge base for the student of Arab and Islamic history, and the contributions of Arabs and Muslims and their civilizational achievements, through familiarity with political history and the development of political, administrative, economic and social institutions by studying the institutions of the caliphate, the ministry and the bureaucracy, land ownership, taxes, agriculture, trade, crafts and items, military system, the structure of Islamic societies, and Education.  |                            |

| <b>5001112</b>          | <b>Law in our Life</b>                        | This course examines the public's knowledge of the law and is concerned with studying the general theory of law, especially in terms of its definition, history, origin, and objectives. It also addresses the distinction between law and the religious norms and ethics. Furthermore, it discusses the basis and nature of law, types of laws, criteria for distinguishing between public law and private law and their branches along with the topics these laws deal with in Jordanian legislation. important Jordanian legislation that affects various aspects of life is another area of interest for this course, too.

| المتطلب السابق: لا يوجد | <b>The Principles of Democracy and Human Rights</b> | <b>5001113</b> |

This course addresses the concepts of democracy and human rights and the relationship between them as it explains the concept of human rights, the religious foundations and philosophy of this concept, the facts of human rights, their types, their different views, the role of international organizations, their relationship with the foreign policies of major countries. It also addresses the causes of human rights violations and ways to combat these violations. Then it begins with addressing international charters and legislations related to human rights, such as the Universal Declaration of Human rights issued by the United Nations General Assembly in 1948 and the two international covenants on these rights issued in 1966. Besides, it deals with addressing the concepts of justice, freedom and equality in different religions and civilizations and areas of convergence and separation between them.

This course discusses the most important contemporary issues of professional ethics in the management of all types of private and governmental organizations. Also, it introduces students to job ethics and work environment and how to employ them in all their professional fields so that they understand the principles and ethical problems in their jobs as well as how to understand and deal with other professions with proper ethical behavior which is a factor for success in practicing the profession in all industrial, service, and commercial sectors. Moreover, it includes learning the nature of the profession and ethical codes for the medical, scientific, and humanitarian professions in the field of social, media and political ethics, confidentiality at work, and the responsibilities to the environment.

The course also covers topics such as starting and operating new projects, management theories and concepts in an entrepreneurial context, components of a business plan and feasibility study, research processes and identifying new opportunities, creativity and entrepreneurial innovation, and the role of the Internet in implementing innovative and pioneering ideas.</p>                 |  |                |

In addition to training student to acquire skills in various job skills such as writing formal letters, applications, a recall letter, an essay, and a report.</p> |  |                |
